



A good dictionary must give example sentences for every word. Example sentences are English sentences which contain a word.

Example sentences are not just helpful - they are actually more important than definitions. While a definition tells you the meaning of a word and (sometimes) gives you some grammatical information, example sentences have at least two advantages:

1. They let you check if you've understood the definition correctly. The meaning of a word can become much clearer if you read a few sentences with the word.

2. They show you how to use a word in sentences. Many words "go with" certain grammar structures (for example, the word "important" is often used in the phrase "It is important to...") or words (for example the word "weather" goes with "forecast" and not "prediction"). Example sentences present this information in a clear way. You can easily copy them to make your own natural sentences.
